ATI FLAT ROLLED PRODUCTS HOLDINGS, LLC (0059-I006b), 100 River Road, Brackenridge, PA 15014-1597, for modification of the following emission limits: PM emissions limits from the F1 AOD/Canopy baghouse; PM emissions limits from the F2 Canopy baghouse; SO_x, NO_x and CO emissions limits from the F1 and F2 DEC baghouses; and SO_x, NO_x, CO and VOCs emission limits from the F1 AOD/Canopy and F2 Canopy baghouses.

ATI FLAT ROLLED PRODUCTS HOLDINGS, LLC (0059-I008c), 100 River Road, Brackenridge, PA 15014-1597, for a modification to correct the previous Installation Permit by identifying the “as-built” emissions sources installed at this facility. The initial Installation Permit identified all sources proposed for installation. This Installation Permit identifies the sources that were actually installed. This group of installed emissions sources is smaller than the proposed group of emissions sources.

RR DONNELLEY HOECHSTETTER (0594-I007), 218 N. Braddock Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15208, for the installation of a new 8-color sheetfed printing press to replace an existing 8-color sheetfed printing press and 4-color sheetfed printing press. The installation will not result in any changes to allowable emissions.

The facility is a synthetic minor source for volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) and a minor source for all other criteria pollutants.

DURA-BOND COATING, INC. (0834), 5 North Linden Street, Duquesne, PA 15110, for the issuance of a Minor Source Operating Permit for specialty coating of steel pipe. The facility is a minor source for all criteria pollutants and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs).

ATI FLAT ROLLED PRODUCTS HOLDINGS, LLC (0059), 100 River Road, Brackenridge, PA 15014-1597, for the production of stainless steel products from scrap and other additives. The facility comprises two (2) electric arc furnaces (EAFs) an argon/oxygen decarburization vessel, a continuous caster, rolling mills, acid treatment facilities various heating furnaces and other smaller sources.
