Part 9: Yard Sales

§ 904 Yard Sales Authorized; Restrictions.

[Ord. 1971, 8/25/2014]

1. Yard sales may be conducted upon residential premises by the owner or occupant thereof, subject to the following limitations:

A. In no case may more than three yard sales be held on any residential premises within a calendar year.

B. No yard sale may be conducted for a period exceeding three consecutive days.

C. No import or stocking of inventory is permitted.

D. Signs/Advertisement:

(1) One sign, with a maximum area of four square feet, advertising the yard sale, shall be permitted on the residential premises where the sale occurs, which shall be removed within four hours after completion of the sale.

(2) No signs or posters advertising the yard sale may be posted on public property such as utility poles, traffic sign standards or within Township, County or State rights-of-way.

(3) No signs or posters advertising the yard sale may be placed on private property without the explicit consent of the property owner.

E. All goods for sale and all sale-related fixtures or equipment shall be removed within four hours of completion of the sale.

F. No yard sale activities shall take place in the public street cartway or upon the public sidewalk.

G. By order of the Harrison Township Police or the Code Enforcement Officer, a yard sale must be discontinued if the sale results in vehicles being parked so as to obstruct traffic or fire truck access, or so as to violate official parking restrictions, or if the sale results in other public nuisance conditions or threatens the public health, safety or welfare.

H. No activity related to any yard sale shall commence before 8:00 a.m., or proceed after 5:00 p.m.
