HARRISON TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS
MANDATED RECYCLING PROGRAM

Harrison Township is required to remind its residents that all residential properties are required to recycle, either at curbside or by some other method at apartment complexes.

All residents are required to recycle the following materials at curbside, on a biweekly schedule. The materials will be collected by the Township's contracted hauler, WASTE MANAGEMENT:

Clear and colored glass bottles and jars
Aluminum beverage and other bimetal cans
Newspaper and magazines
Plastic bottles & containers marked #1 – 5 & 7
Flattened cardboard & paperboard

A recycling trailer is available at the Municipal Building 24 hours a day for the deposit of mixed paper and cardboard. Small businesses also are welcome to use the recycling trailer.

Leaf waste is collected by the Township along with branches and hedge clippings. These must be placed in brown paper bags only. The Township cannot accept plastic bags since the materials are composted and cannot process plastic. The resulting aged compost is available free to the public at the compost pile across from the Municipal office on Municipal Drive.
