

## **Harrison Township Information For Disposal of Household Building Material**

Waste Management is the current Harrison Township refuse contractor. Waste Management does not pick-up during their weekly garbage route any household building materials, such as dry wall, wood, plumbing fixtures, brick or cement pieces, concrete block and similar items.

The quarterly charge property owners pay for garbage pickup is based on what the refuse contractor pays at the landfill, which is based on weight. The excess weight from building material would result in a much higher quarterly charge for everyone. Each household that has building materials to dispose is responsible for the cost of disposing their own building materials.

Township Property Maintenance ordinances require that household building materials and other garbage and trash shall not accumulate in and around your property. If this material is not disposed of properly, property owners are subject to a citation and fine.

### **Disposal of household building material can be arranged as follows:**

- Waste Management (the Township's contracted refuse contractor for routine garbage collection) has "bagster" options for households. Check out how it works by going to the internet at [thebagster.com](http://thebagster.com).
- Residents can contact any commercial trash service or construction contractors and make arrangements to pick-up unwanted building material.
- Residents also can personally make a trip to a local landfill. McCuthcheon Enterprises is the landfill in this region that accepts material from individuals as well as commercial customers.
